

USING THE NICA COVID-19 ANTIBODY THERAPY LOCATOR

Since the first COVID-19 therapeutics became available, NICA has been working closely with the distributor to add new treatment locations after each allocation period. NICA then processes this data to make it more consumer-friendly and help ensure our Locator listings reflect *care settings* rather than shipment receiving locations.

To use the NICA COVID-19 Antibody Therapy Locator:

1. Visit <https://covid.infusioncenter.org/>
2. Enter your city and state, or your zip code and click “search.”
3. The default search radius is 30 miles. If results do not populate for the area searched, try increasing the search radius.
4. Click on a location to view site details including phone number, hours of operation, website, amenities, and more.

IMPORTANT NOTES

- Search results may show both “claimed” and “unclaimed” sites of care—this only refers to whether or not that site administrator has signed in and updated the listing profile to customize things like hours of operation, amenities, etc.
 - If a site is listed in the locator, it has received allocation of one or more of the COVID-19 antibody therapeutics; however, inclusion in this tool does not imply current availability of doses.
- These antibody therapies are restricted to certain high-risk individuals and require a drug order (similar to a prescription) from a health care provider (HCP) for eligible patients.
- HCPs must verify eligibility of their patients and verify the availability of doses at an authorized infusion site before they refer an eligible patient to schedule an appointment to receive treatment at an authorized infusion site.
